

Our Wagner Family Tree

Genealogy according to Fred (W) Wagner

Page 1: Fred did not have a middle name, so he "adopted" the initial W
1802-1874

1. Phillip George Wagner was born June 10, 1802 in Kriegsfeld, Germany. He married Barbara Fuchs (Fox) who was born May 31, 1809 in Orbis, Germany. The date of their marriage is not available. The couple migrated to America in 1839, and settled in Tiverton Township, Coshocton County, Ohio. He came to work on the Ohio Canal. He was one of the canal diggers. Philip died October 8, 1874 and Barbara died in 1854, both in Tiverton Township. No marked grave to either of them. A piece of paper in the family bible has the names, birthdays, and death years. One person, Anna Elizabeth Wagner, died on November 17, 1824, in Kriegsfeld, Germany. The record is handwritten on paper in the Family Bible given to me by Fred. W. Wagner. On this paper it refers to a son, Philip George Wagner and the father Philip George Wagner. There were three children of this marriage.
 - 1.1. *Katherine (**Barbara**) Wagner, born January 9, 1830. She married Valentine Kraft, February 16, 1850. They migrated to Wisconsin. There is no record after migration.*
 - 1.2. *Philip (**George**) Wagner was born December 5, 1832. He married Eva Stuber on October 14, 1855. He died about 1910 in Long Beach, Orange Co. CA. Eva died on Dec. 29, 1901 in Peabody, Kansas. Eva Stuber was the daughter of Phil Stuber and was born in July 11, 1837 in Spesbach, Rheine, Bavaria. They had 8 children.*
 - 1.3. *John (**Johannes**) Wagner was born December 8, 1835 in Kriegsfeld, Germany. He migrated to America in 1839. He was married to Elizabeth Kaiser on Nov. 27, 1859. They settled in Tiverton Twp. in Coshocton County. There is a second note that states they lived in Wolf Creek near Killbuck, Ohio. John died September 23, 1908 in Warsaw County. Elizabeth Kaiser was born January 28, 1841 in Ohio. She died on May 19, 1917 and is buried in Warsaw.*

1832-1920

- 1.2. Philip George Wagner** (son) married Eva Stuber. They had four children:
- 1.2.1. *Philip Wagner, son of Philip George Wagner –according to Fred W Wagner this Philip left no heirs and died in 1909.*
 - 1.2.2. *George Wagner, son of Philip Wagner (according to Fred W. Wagner he also left no heirs.) He died in 1925 in Peabody, KA. (Note by Judy Mason—this information seems to be in error. I have found descendants of George Wagner online. Refer to my addendum)*
 - 1.2.3. *Rose Wagner, daughter of Philip Wagner married John Clark. They had one daughter, Florence. Record ends.*
 - 1.2.4. *Flora Wagner, daughter of Philip Wagner. No record available. 1835-1908*
- 1.3. John Wagner married Elizabeth Kaiser.** They had three children:
- 1.3.1. *The first child died in infancy. Born and died Dec. 7, 1860. The record does not state the sex of this child. John was a teacher and served 2 terms as the Treasurer of Coshocton County.*
 - 1.3.2. **John Franklin Wagner** was born November 5, 1861 and married Amanda Grimes in 1889. (My great grandfather and great grandmother) John and Amanda bought the farm on Bowman Rd in Mansfield, Ohio. He died January 23, 1926. Amanda Mabel Grimes was born April 27, 1865. She was a dressmaker and seamstress. She lived with her daughter, Gladys, after John died.
 - 1.3.3. *Margaret Emma Wagner was born November 5, 1865 and married Fred Shuy in 1899. They had a son who married but no other information is available and a daughter.*

1861-1926

- 1.3.2. John Franklin Wagner and Amanda Grimes** had two children:
- 1.3.2.1. *Fred (W) Wagner was born September 18, 1891 and died on January 2, 1978. Fred married Edith Ethel Hauger, on October 14, 1917 in Nellie, Ohio. The ceremony was performed by the Rev. Edward B. Shaw. Edith was born December 13, 1894; in she died on April 25, 1981, in Mansfield, OH. The place of birth for both is unknown. Her mother was Alida McElroy Hauger.*
 - 1.3.2.2. *Gladys Wagner never married and had a son, Elza out of wedlock. She died in 1960 in Mansfield, Ohio.*
- 1.3.3. Margaret Emma Wagner and Fred Shuy** had two children:
- 1.3.3.1. *John Shuy married Zella Pearl Hayes. They had two children:*
 - 1.3.3.1.1 *Margaret Shuy who married Dean Deatch*
 - 1.3.3.1.2 *Miriam (Marion) Shuy who married Arthur Warner*
 - 1.3.3.2. *Eva May Shuy. She never married.*
